Dr. Kathie Lin is an Assistant Professor of Neurology and Neurological Sciences at Stanford University. She practices both Neuromuscular Medicine and Comprehensive Neurology in Emeryville and Palo Alto. Additionally, she is interested in medical education and developing a practical framework for teaching neurology and neurophysiology to medical students and neurology residents.
