Kevin C. Moore is an Advanced Lecturer in the Program in Writing and Rhetoric (PWR), and the Coordinator of PWR's Notation in Science Communication. He holds a PhD in English from UCLA (2013). Prior to arriving at Stanford, he taught in the Writing Program at the University of California, Santa Barbara (2013-2019). His research interests include science and rhetoric, propaganda studies, Ralph Ellison, and writer's block. Dr. Moore's work has appeared in *Arizona Quarterly*, *Arts*, *ContraSTS*, *Writing on the Edge*, *African American Review*, *Composition Studies*, *MAKE*, *Souciant*, and the *Santa Barbara Independent*, as well as collections such as *Trigger Warnings: Teaching through Trauma* (Lever Press 2026), *Ralph Ellison in Context* (Cambridge University Press 2021), and *Creative Ways of Knowing in Engineering* (Springer 2017). He also writes fiction and creative nonfiction.
