Patricia Blessing is Associate Professor of Art and Art History at Stanford University. Blessing is the author of *Rebuilding Anatolia after the Mongol Conquest: Islamic Architecture in the Lands of Rüm, 1240–1330* (Ashgate, 2014) and *Architecture and Material Politics in the Fifteenth-century Ottoman Empire* (Cambridge University Press, 2022). With Elizabeth Dospel Williams and Eiren Shea, she co-authored *Medieval Textiles across Eurasia, c. 300-1400* for the Cambridge Elements series *Global Middle Ages* (Cambridge University Press, 2023). Blessing's work has been supported by the ANAMED Research Center for Anatolian Cultures, the Barakat Trust, the British Academy, the Gerda Henkel Foundation, the International Center of Medieval Art, the Samuel H. Kress Foundation, and the Society of Architectural Historians.
