At Stanford, she works on the inpatient service, outpatient geropsychiatry clinic and the electroconvulsive therapy service. In addition to her clinical and research interests, she is passionate about patient advocacy and promoting mental health legislative changes to benefit patient care and has testified in state senate hearings to that end as a physician representative of organizations like the Northern California Psychiatric Association and American Psychiatric Association.
