Dr. Chu is an experienced postdoctoral researcher who has built a strong track record at Academia Sinica, Taiwan. He completed his Ph.D. in Biophysics and Physical Chemistry at the Institute of Atomic and Molecular Sciences (IAMS), gaining expertise in single-molecule imaging, molecular mechanisms, and data analysis. He then applied these imaging skills to neuroscience research at the Institute of Molecular Biology (IMB), with a focus on autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS).

Beyond his rigorous research, Dr. Chu studied law at National Taiwan University (NTU) in preparation for the bar examination. He is now taking credit-bearing graduate courses in electrical engineering and AI at Stanford University through the Center for Global and Online Education (CGOE), working toward the advanced degrees.
