I am an Attending Radiologist in the Department of Diagnostic, Interventional and Pediatric Radiology at Inselspital, Bern University Hospital.

I received my M.D. from the University of Bern in 2016 and obtained board certification in Radiology in 2020. In 2025, I earned the European Board of Interventional Radiology (EBIR). I further completed a fellowship in Interventional Radiology at Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin.

My clinical work focuses on minimally invasive image-guided oncologic and vascular interventions, with particular expertise in interventional oncology.

My procedural spectrum includes CT-guided lung biopsy, liver-directed therapies such as TACE, SIRT, and TIPS, as well as percutaneous tumor ablation.
