Professor Carolyn Springer came to Stanford in 1985 after receiving a Ph.D. in Italian language and literature from Yale University. She has received fellowships and awards from the American Academy in Rome, the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, the Harvard Center for Italian Renaissance Studies / Villa I Tatti, the Ford Foundation, and the Fulbright Foundation. Her research has focused primarily on Renaissance and nineteenth-century literature and cultural history. She has published articles and reviews in *Annali d'italianistica*, *Boundary 2: A Journal of Postmodern Literature*, *Canadian Journal of Italian Studies*, *Forum Italicum*, *GRADIVA: International Journal of Literature*, *The International Journal of the Humanities*, *Italian Quarterly*, *The Italianist*, *Italica* (Journal of the American Association of Italian Studies), *Modern Language Studies*, *NEMLA Italian Studies*, *Quaderni d'italianistica*, *Renaissance Quarterly*, *Sixteenth Century Journal*, *Stanford Italian Review*, *Versus: Quaderni di studi semiotici*, *Woman's Art Journal*, *The Wordsworth Circle*, and *Yale Italian Studies*. Professor Springer's books include *The Marble Wilderness: Ruins and Representation in Italian Romanticism, 1775-1850* (Cambridge University Press, 1987; reprinted in paperback, 2010); *Immagini del Novecento italiano* (Macmillan, coeditors Pietro Frassica and Giovanni Pacchiano); and *History and Memory in European Romanticism* (special issue of *Stanford Literature Review*).
