She received her training from the University of London's School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine and Hanoi Medical University. Throughout her career, she has led impactful public health efforts with organizations including the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Asian Liver Center at Stanford University.

Her expertise spans viral hepatitis, infectious diseases, HIV/AIDS, and reproductive health, with a strong focus on data analytics, health systems strengthening, and behavioral change communication. Deeply committed to advancing health equity, Dr. Pham works to improve outcomes for underserved populations across a wide range of settings.

She has authored numerous peer-reviewed publications, offering key insights on hepatitis screening and surveillance, health disparities, cost-effectiveness modeling, administrative claims analysis, and electronic health record - based interventions. Her research has contributed to both national and global policies on viral hepatitis prevention and care.

A dedicated mentor and educator, Dr. Pham has supported the development of many interns and early-career professionals, and she serves as a co-instructor in public health training programs.
