As the Assistant Director of the Learning Health Systems (LHS) Program at Stanford's Quantitative Sciences Unit (QSU), I have led the establishment and expansion of the program, fostering key collaborations in quality improvement studies, pragmatic trials, and real-world evidence research. The program implements and evaluates innovative approaches, such as LLM-based or machine-learning-based AI tools, user-specific dashboards, clinical workflow enhancements, and provider and patient education, all underpinned by rigorous statistical principles and advanced modeling techniques to optimize healthcare delivery and decision-making. To support these initiatives, I have developed comprehensive statistical resources, standard operating procedures, and analysis plan templates, while also building a specialized team of statisticians and data scientists. As the program lead, I oversee training efforts, mentor team members, and facilitate onboarding for clinical collaborators, ensuring a strong foundation for continued research and implementation excellence.

In my scientific role as a Senior Biostatistician, I collaborate with clinical researchers, public health agencies, and industry partners to integrate real-world evidence into clinical and public health research. My expertise lies in study design, implementation, and dissemination, particularly in leveraging Electronic Health Records (EHRs), claims data, and registry databases for health policy, hospital quality improvement, and public health initiatives. I have extensive experience designing and analyzing randomized clinical trials (RCTs), pragmatic trials, and stepped-wedge trial designs, ensuring rigorous statistical methodologies and regulatory compliance.

My primary statistical interests include quasi-experimental designs (e.g., difference-in-difference, interrupted time series), multilevel modeling, missing data techniques, and causal inference. I have served as the lead author on multiple statistical methodology manuscripts.

In terms of mentorship, I supervise junior statisticians and serve as a KL2 methodological research mentor for early-career clinical researchers at Stanford. I also contribute to statistical education by delivering lectures in QSU's statistical methods seminar series for clinical researchers, co-leading the workshop for the 2021 Women in Data Science Conference, and presenting at major statistical conferences such as the Joint Statistical Meetings and Current Statistical Practice 2023.
