Before joining Stanford, Dr. Miller worked at the American Chemical Society in their Publications Division to launch the ACS Center for Laboratory Safety and the journal ACS Chemical Health & Safety. She led a variety of society-wide safety initiatives and oversaw an industrial and chemical safety portfolio of three scientific journals. Previously, Kali also worked as a lab manager at the Beckman Institute to support research in interdisciplinary lab spaces and participated in the Illinois Joint Safety Team, founding a National ACS workshop on student laboratory safety teams.
