As the Lead Storage Facility Worker at Stanford Auxiliary Library 3, I oversee warehousing operations encompassing a 70,000 square foot high security, environmentally controlled, high-density storage facility that currently is home for 4.8 million items, consuming 33,000 locations on almost 6 acres. Currently lead a team of five union workers that perform shipping, receiving, transportation and inventory control operations that support the movement of inventory with cultural and historical relevance to the Stanford community and the world at large. Oversee inventory movement into and out of the operation to ensure inventory security, integrity and preservation of fragile items.
