Between operational assignments, he attended US Navy Test Pilot School on a cooperative program with the Naval Postgraduate School where he earned an MS in aeronautical engineering. He commanded a helicopter squadron, the Grandmasters (HSL 46), and the amphibious assault carrier, USS Bonhomme Richard (LHD 6). His financial management experience began as a budget program analyst in the Pentagon. In addition, he has an MBA from University of Colorado. He was Associate Vice Provost for Finance and Administration in VPUE until 2018. He was CFO of University of Colorado Colorado Springs until 2022.
